#### Safety and the COPS program

And now for the final topic, our safety and security. As you know, we also have a Safety Committee that administers the COPS program. While a handful of generous, caring residents cover the costs for an inadequate amount of patrol hours, many other neighbors have a cavalier attitude that "someone else will pay for patrol and I will benefit".

We are nearing the end of the road for that program. Rates for Elk Grove Police off-duty patrol have increased, and paid members have decreased. Our funds have been depleted so much that we can only pay for a measly 20 hours of patrol per month. That's absolutely next to nothing. That's 5 shifts at 4 hrs each. That's not fair for those who pay and others who don't (yet expect patrol to come at no cost to them).

But you can solve this dilemma if you have yet to join the COPS program! There's hope that we can reach a membership goal of 500 paid members! This will allow us to cover the costs of nearly 140 random (unpredictable to criminals) hours of off-duty police patrol per month!

Paid members will soon be surveyed about options to continue patrol whether through EGPD (current method) or Private Patrol (non-law enforcement service).
