COPS

(Camden Officer Patrol Service)

Participation: COPS is a program of focused EGPD patrol through our Camden Passage/Park neighborhoods. The police officers provide extra patrol and can monitor car and foot traffic of the neighborhood and get to know who lives in our neighborhoods. The more participants we have the more patrol hours we can fund each month. In an effort to maintain the few hours each month noted above, we need at least 114 consistently paying COPS members. Our COPS program has led to Camden being one of the safest communities in Elk

Grove. Please consider joining COPS so coverage can expand.

VOLUNTEER(S) NEEDED - In response to former COPS participants on the effectiveness of the COPS program, we seek a volunteer to the Safety Committee that can compile patrol reports on a quarterly basis for distribution to COPS members as part of the perks of participation. YOU LIVE IN CAMDEN. time to keep it pretty and nice...

One of the many positive features of Camden has always been our beautiful homes and landscape. Things to keep in mind because you can help the community thrive and remain desirable by checking on a few items listed below. We always hope our entire community realizes the value of a beautiful neighborhood. Many have moved to Camden because of the big trees and lovely landscaping of our yards. Some reminders from the City's Codes and the CC&Rs require:

- All properties to be well maintained with no garbage, garbage cans, debris or accumulations of junk items on the front driveways or courtyards, or visible from the street
- Auto repair service is not allowed in residential neighborhoods. Storage of inoperable vehicles and accumulation of vehicles is not allowed on driveways or streets.
- RV and Boat Parking The City of Elk Grove has ordinances that prohibit recreational vehicles, trailers, and large duty (greater than 4 tons gross vehicle weight) commercial truck parking on driveways or in front yards of residential lots. There are exceptions such as if the RV or boat is screened from view and located at least 20 feet back from the sidewalk. or through the 2006 grandfathered clause. There are also codes regarding leaving any vehicle parked in the same spot on public streets for more than 72 hours.

Our 2023 Music by the Lake event drew close to 2000 people. On August 19th everyone from 1 to 100 years old danced the night away to the Cover Me Badd live band. We had many wonderful prizes to raffle, food trucks, a huge slide for the kids and local vendors selling their wares.

October 28th brought the Halloween Fall Festival and Crafts: Grilled Hot Dogs and carnival games- what could be better? When you add in trick-or treat goodies, a bounce slide and craft vendors, you have a perfect neighborhood event for kids and adults alike! We do this for the enjoyment of all our residents in Camden!

Pictures with Santa & Wagon Rides! On Dec 3rd Camden was lucky to get a special visit by Santa and his elves during our event, making for the perfect family picture opportunity. Kids decorated cookies and drank hot chocolate gearing up for the holiday season. We even provided train rides during this festive event! Then Dec 10th we enjoyed an evening of horse drawn wagon rides! The wagon rides were a big hit offering large seating capacity allowing groups and families to ride and sing carols while touring the streets viewing holiday decorations! It was so popular we're bringing it back again this year. With your paid membership, CNA members get a priority reservation window and we guarantee the wagon rides will sell out his year.

Our Outdoor Holiday Decoration Contest had homes bringing beauty, fun, and a festive atmosphere to our incredible neighborhood. We had special prizes for them voted by CNA residents.

After a long, rainy winter our 2024 Spring Faire brought folks out to enjoy a sunny day. We had carnival games at this year's event and they were a hit with the kids. A scavenger map sent kids & parents to our local vendors to see their wares and collect candy and stickers. Two fabulous raffle baskets, one filled with items for kids and one geared towards parents, were won by lucky Camdenites.

On March 30th the Easter Bunny delivered adorable Baskets with candy-filled eggs adorned with a cuddly bunny and bow. They were only \$1 for members!

During April, we always band together for **Earth Day 2024** cleanup of our lakes, creeks and surrounding areas. Lately, our event received support from the all-volunteer Elk Grove Anti-Trash Group. This year saw hundreds of pounds of trash pulled from the lakes, parks, and trails. Good job!

We ended our fiscal year with the Camden Annual Garage Sale held the first Saturday in June. Hundreds of people from all over Sacramento and Elk Grove visited over 40 participating homes following an online map provided by fellow CNA member Leanne Slaton and Brittany Davis of The House Sisters Keller Williams Realty. It was a win-win as buyers got lots of bargains and Camdenites have less clutter and money to buy more stuff!

And as always, we held our Annual Community Meeting and Board election on June 10. We remain grateful for the time spent by local officials to attend our meeting and talk with us about issues that matter for quality of life.

We began the 2024 Summer season with Movies on the Greenbelt. Bringing the kids, a blanket, and lawn chairs, families enjoyed a movie with neighbors on the Cooperston Greenbelt. Join the fun August 23rd for the next Movie event.
