# CAMDEN PRIDE, CAMDEN STRONG = CAMDEN APPEAL

The Camden Neighborhood Association is pleased to see a positive upswing in the overall care and maintenance of our residences and yards! Camden Pride seems to be returning in full force! A little bit goes a long way in keeping our Camden appeal strong. But it bears repeating from our Winter/Spring newsletter as a simple reminder: We've listed a few highlights that pertain to the most frequent questions and concerns. While we care about our community, we encourage you to be diplomatic and reach out to your neighbors first before contacting authorities. You might just end up finding common ground. **RV Parking**: The City of Elk Grove has ordinances that prohibit recreational vehicles, trailers, and large duty (greater than 4 tons gross vehicle weight) commercial truck parking on driveways or in front yards of residential lots. There are also codes regarding leaving any vehicle parked in the same spot on public streets for more than 72 hours.

**Fencing**: The City of Elk Grove has ordinances requiring fencing to be maintained in front yards and along side yards next to streets. Setbacks are required and we suggest checking out that information on the City's website or in our CCRs.

**Landscaping:** For example, the CCRs section 2.07 in Camden Passage West call for "landscaping shall be maintained thereafter as well as or better than the average residence in the overall subdivision". Basically, Camden lots should be well maintained

**Trash and Refuse Disposal**: For example, the CCR section 2.18 requires "no portion of the property shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage, or other waste shall not be kept except in covered, fly proof, sanitary containers which shall be kept where they are not visible from the street..."

**Care of Lots**: CCRs Section 2.20 discusses the care of lots. "No weeds, underbrush, or unsightly growth shall be permitted to grow on any lot... No refuse pile or unsightly object shall be allowed to be placed or suffered to remain on any lot." The City of Elk Grove also exercises authority on weed growth and garbage piles on front parts of lots.

**Vehicle Repairs**: Both the City Code and the CC&Rs limit auto repairs on residential lots. CCR Section 2.26 states that no vehicle of any type shall be permanently or semi-permanently parked...on any lot for the purpose of accomplishing repairs thereto or reconstruction thereof, except for emergency repairs.

Off-duty police patrol our neighborhoods monitoring car and foot traffic of those they don't live in the neighborhood. They know who doesn't live in the neighborhood because the same officers patrol our

grounds every month. Curious how to join the COPS program? It's easy! Simply enroll once on our website or by checking the box on the form in this newsletter and return the form. You will be billed, or set up autopay through your bank to pay monthly, quarterly or yearly. More residents enrolled in the COPS program allows us to schedule more hours of patrols. COPS \$20/monthly. Every joining member makes our neighborhood safer.
