- Weedy unkempt landscaping, broken or missing fencing, poor care of lots, and homes needing TLC or fresh paint
- Trash and unsightly debris accumulation and waste carts left out front in plain view
- Vehicle repairs and commercial/industrial private business done in residential neighborhoods
